Pursuant to EU Reg. 2016/679, ANICA informs that the data communicated above will be processed and used for the performance of institutional tasks related to the identification and registration of the horse, as well as provided to public or private entities, in charge of carrying out, on behalf of the Association, activities functional to the performance of these tasks.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE FOR FOALS BORN IN ITALY

(Decree of 30 September 2021 "Management and operation of the equine registry" art. 5 paragraph 3)

1. Submission of Birth Communication

The birth communication must be uploaded to the Database (**BDN**) **within 60 days of birth**. Owners are advised to notify ANICA well in advance to allow the secretariat to complete the upload within this timeframe.

Methods of transmission:

- **Online:** via the ANICA portal (www.anicahorse.org) through the reserved area.
- **Offline:** by fax or email by filling out **Form 2/A**.

Required documents to be sent with Form 2/A:

- Copy of the **registration fee payment**.
- **CIF** (Certificate of Fertilization Intervention): the kit cannot be sent without this.
- **CIE** (Certificate of Embryo Implantation) for foals born via Embryo Transfer (ET).
- **Breeding Certificate** for matings with foreign stallions.

2. The Identification Kit

Once the complete birth communication is received, the ANICA office will send an **identification kit** within 60 days, which includes:

- **MOD 2B** (Identification form).
- **Transponder** (Microchip).
- **Bag** for the collection of horsehair.
- *Note:* Only microchips supplied by ANICA may be used for Purebred Arabian (PSA) foals.

3. Identification Requirements

- **Timing:** Foals must be identified by a veterinarian while still with the mother and **before leaving the birth stud farm**.
- **Signatures:** Form IIB must be signed by both the **veterinarian** and the **owner**.
- **Markings:** Form II/B must be completed with care; white markings on the horse must be drawn in **red pen** on the diagram.

4. Final Documentation to ANICA

The following must be sent to the ANICA Secretariat via **registered mail**:

- **MOD. II/B** (original, fully completed and signed).
- **Original CIF** (or equivalent foreign mating document).
- **Original CIE** (for ET foals).
- **Hair sample** (with hair bulb) in a special bag sealed by the veterinarian.

5. Important Rules and Prohibitions

- **WAHO Bans:** In vitro insemination (IVF) and cloning are **strictly forbidden**; foals born through these methods **cannot be registered**.
- **Intended Use:** You must specify if the foal is **DPA** (intended for food consumption) or **non-DPA**. If left blank, the foal will default to DPA. Registration after 12 months of age results in automatic non-DPA status.
- **Processing Time:** It takes approximately **90 days** from the arrival of all original documentation to issue the passport.
